ARABIAN HORSE PAINTING HORSE EXPO – 2009

Once again, MLAHA joined forces with Castle Rock Arabians to present a rare opportunity to children visiting the Horse Expo Children's Pavilion – hand

painting a live Arabian horse. As camera-happy parents looked on, children dipped their hands into pots of paint and decorated the white Arabian horses with handprints, swirls of mixed colors, dots, and exciting murals.

The children's ages ranged from 3 to teenagers, and all had a good time. Kathy Vrablick, project leader, kept supplies stocked, directed the horse handling team, and instructed each group of children on safety and manner rules around horses. When finished, she presented each artist with a special sticker. Kathy spent three days and nights caring for the horses, organizing and training horse handlers, and worked tirelessly with each of the 9 groups of painters, her granddaughter, Madison, her tireless helper. The MLAHA youth, their parents and grandparents, and other MLAHA representatives comprise the handlers, along with the Castle Rock Arabians youth.



There are four Arabian mares who participate in this activity, and a small gentle Welsh pony for the littlest children. Each horse has a handler who makes sure both the children and the horses are safe. After each session the horses are paraded through the Horse Expo grounds to the bathing area, and given a cooling scrub. This year, we were fortunate to have great weather. See you next year!

Mohave SSR was the result of a breeding to bring out the best temperament and conformation in the Arabian English Pleasure horse. He is double crossed to Bask++, and has strong Polish bloodlines which give him height and strength. Mohave is 15.3.

Mohave has been shown in Region 7 and was the Reserve Champion Sport Horse Gelding in-hand at Scottsdale in a class of 14. He has not been shown under saddle, but his training is solid. Mohave is a willing, easy horse to ride with a friendly attitude. He gets along well with other horses. In addition to his arena work under saddle, he has been ridden on the trail, and he enjoys being out in the countryside. He is a family horse, and will do well in shows or on trails with his training, attitude, and the flashiness of his long white socks.

VOLUNTARY RELEASE OF LIABILITY, ASSUMPTION OF RISK AND INDEMNITY

I, as a participant in the Mother Lode Arabian Horse Association Trail Trials, acknowledge that horseback riding is a dangerous sport which carries inherent risks of injury, death and damage to myself, my horse, other people and their horses and property. I also acknowledge that horses themselves have unpredictable temperaments that can sometimes cause injury and damage. I acknowledge that even the most experienced horse activity sponsor cannot guarantee my safety as a participant. THEREFORE, BY SIGNING BELOW, I KNOWINGLY ASSUME THE UNAVOIDABLE RISKS INHERENT IN ALL HORSE-RELATED ACTIVITIES, WHETHER KNOWN OR UNKNOWN, INCLUDING BUT NOT LIMITED TO BODILY INJURY AND PHYSICAL HARM TO HORSE, RIDER AND SPECTATOR, AND AGREE TO THE FOLLOWING ON BEHALF OF MYSELF AND MY SPOUSE, IF ANY:

- 1. I HEREBY RELEASE AND DISCHARGE THE MOTHER LODE ARABIAN HORSE ASSOCIATION (MLAHA), ITS AGENTS, EMPLOYEES, MEMBERS, VOLUNTEERS, SUCCESSORS AND ASSIGNS, AND CALIFORNIA STATE PARKS, (HEREINAFTER COLLECTIVELY REFERRED TO AS "RELEASEES") FROM ALL ACTIONS CLAIMS OR DEMANDS I MAY NOW OR HEREAFTER HAVE FROM INJURY DEATH OR DAMAGE RESULTING FROM MY PARTICIPATION IN THIS ACTIVITY.
- 2. I ALSO HEREBY AGREE NOT TO SUE RELEASEES FOR INJURY, DEATH OR DAMAGE RESULTING FROM MY PARTICIPATION IN THIS ACTIVITY AS A RESULT OF THE UNAVAILABILITY OF EMERGENCY MEDICAL CARE, NEGLIGENCE OR DELIBERATE ACT BY RELEASEES OR ANY OTHER PARTICIPANT.
- 3. In consideration of my participation in events organized or sponsored by MLAHA, I waive, release and discharge Releases' from any and all claim or liability for injury or damage to myself, my animals or my property arising out of my participation.
- 4. I also expressly waive any rights I may have under California Civil Code 1542, which states: "A general release does not extend to claims which the creditor does not know or suspect to exist in his favor at the time of executing the release, which if known by him must have materially affected his settlement with the debtor."
- 5. I agree that I will defend, indemnify and hold harmless Releases' against all claims, demands, and causes of action, including court costs and actual attorney's fees, arising from any proceeding or lawsuit brought against them due to any act done by me, or brought by me or for my benefit.
- 6. I understand that it is the sole responsibility of the participant to carry full and complete insurance coverage of his/her horse, personal property and him/herself. I acknowledge that I have been advised to wear protective headgear and hard soled boots with a heel.
- 7. I represent and acknowledge that I currently have no ailments, physical or mental conditions or previously known physical or mental conditions that would or could be adversely affected by my participation in this activity. I further represent that my horse is free from contagious or transmissible disease or infection.
- 8. This agreement is binding on my executors, heirs and assigns. It contains the entire agreement between the parties.
- 9. This agreement shall be constructed and enforced with, and governed by, the laws of the State of California.
- 10. I HAVE READ THIS RELEASE AND WAIVER OF LIABILITY AND INDEMNITY AGREEMENT CAREFULLY AND COMPLETELY, AND FULLY UNDERSTAND ITS CONTENTS. I AM AWARE THAT THIS IS A RELEASE OF LIABILITY AND A CONTRACT BETWEEN MYSELF AND RELEASES, AND I SIGN IT OF MY OWN FREE WILL. I FURTHER AGREE THAT NO ORAL REPRESENTATION, STATEMENTS OR INDUCEMENTS APART FROM THE FOREGOING WRITTEN AGREEMENT HAVE BEEN MADE, AND THAT I RELY ON NONE. I UNDERSTAND THAT MY SIGNATURE BELOW AFFECTS MY LEGAL RIGHTS.
